- Provide budget (cost estimate) and payback for recommended energy projects for buildings and water/wastewater treatment plants.
- Develop integrated energy and sustainability plan.
- Identify low cost/no cost energy savings.
- Review and/or development of Energy and Water Management Plan/Policy.
- Evaluation of heating, ventilation, air-conditioning, and controls.
- **ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager training.**
- Facility specific Energy Technical Assistance and benchmarking.
- Identification of possible funding options to implement energy cost reduction measures.

The final deliverable for this program is an engineering report (PEA) which serves as an effective planning document.
