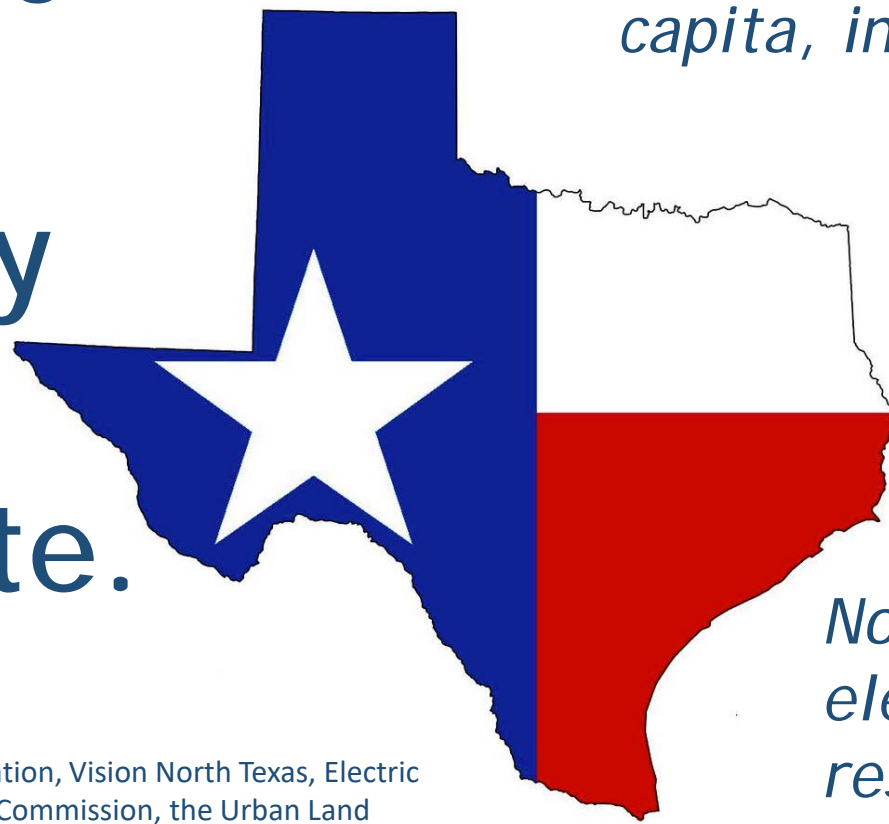


Why ENERGY USE in North Central Texas Matters

TODAY

Texas uses more electricity than any other state.



Texas ranks 6th nationally, per capita, in terms of energy use.

By 2050, North Texans will need more than 20% more production capacity than is currently available.

North Texas residents use 10% more electricity than residents from the rest of the state.

MEANWHILE.... ENERGY DEMAND IS GROWING

Because of:

Population Growth

- North Texas grows by 1 person every 3.6 minutes
- The North Texas region is expected to have over 11 million residents by 2050
- Dallas/ Fort Worth is the #5 Real Estate Market in the country

Climate

- Rising temperatures correspond with rising peak demand

Affluence

- Per capita income is expected to increase by 32% over the next 20 years, which is linked to higher spending and energy use
